

ASAP Term 4 Classes for 2011-12 School Year

TEEN THURSDAYS

DRAWING for REAL Shaun Conroy, instructor

For both beginning and advanced middle & high school students. Spend Thursday afternoons exploring the fundamentals of drawing, shading and perspective. Pencil, colored pencil, charcoal, and pen and ink media will be introduced. Individual instruction is a hallmark of Mr. Conroy's teaching. Students will complete three main drawings, as well as a practice sketchbook, and will have a strong foundation in draftsmanship by the end of this course.

First through Sixth Grade ASAP Classes

Monday: Public Art/Creative Writing. Design and apply embellishments for an 11 foot replica blue marlin that is to be dropped at The Wharf on New Year's Eve. Made possible by a grant from Odyssey Events. Taught by Belinda Butler.

Tuesday: Mixed Media. Acrylic painting with a variety of additional media. Zack Baisden's 37 years of teaching experience help him provide individual instruction as he teaches layered painting techniques and adding texture to flat patterns.
